

Pomelle Mahogany

BOTANICAL NAMES Entandrophragma Cylindricum

TRADE NAMES Baywood, Mogano, Mahagoni, Mahogany.

GROWTH AREA Africa

TECHNOLOGICAL FEATURES

The many small knots of varying sizes, arranged next to each other, are the distinctive feature of this wood. The many dark brown sinuosities are the result of a structural defect in the log due to a different composition of the wood fibers. Unlike the burls, these bubbles and knots are not caused by the formation of buds, which are incorporated prematurely into the log fibres.

DRYING METHOD

Tending only on rare occasions to crack, this wood is easily dried
